BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending December 6, which included Thanksgiving day, were \$8,615,000,000, or only slightly less than for the preceding week. This practically undiminished volume of debits in spite of the fact that the week contained only five business days is due mainly to the large volume of end-of-month transactions. While smaller figures are reported for most of the leading centers, many others, including Boston, Pittsburgh and New Orleans, show larger figures than the week before.

For the corresponding week in 1921 bank debits were \$8,965,000,000, or somewhat more than for the week under review. This difference is due to the fact that last year the week ended December 7 and did not include Thanksgiving day, while this year it ended December 6 and included the holiday. As compared with last year many of the centers show smaller figures, though increased debits are reported for Cleveland, Cincinnati, Pittsburgh and several centers in the South and middle and far West.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 248 centers, of which 164 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
