BANK DEBITS.

Bank debits for the week ending December 13 were \$8,509,000,000, or \$112,000,000 less than for the preceding week, which included Thanksgiving day and consisted of only five business days. This recession is in accordance with the customary trend for the second week of the month. Among the leading centers substantial declines compared with the preceding week are shown for New York, Boston and New Orleans, while other centers, particularly Pittsburgh, report much larger figures than the week before.

For the corresponding week in 1921 bank debits were \$8,344,000,000, or about \$165,000,000 less than for the week under review. Substantially smaller figures than a year ago are reported for New York and Baltimore, while debits for Pittsburgh are nearly twice as large as for the corresponding week in 1921.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 248 centers, of which 164 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
