## BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending May 9 totaled \$9,527,000,000, marking a decline of \$1,529,000,000, or of 13.8 per cent from the exceptionally large total of \$11,056,000,000 for the preceding week. Smaller totals for the week are reported for all the leading cities, except Pittsburgh, Washington, Atlanta and Denver. For New York City the decrease was \$970,000,000, or 63.4 per cent of the total decrease shown.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1922 aggregate debits for the report week show an increase of \$451,000,000, or of about 5 per cent. Outside of New York (243 cities) the total increase was \$876,000,000, while for New York City a decrease of \$425,000,000 is shown.

Debits to individual accounts are reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities. The total number of cities covered by this week's report is 253, of which 244 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
