BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending July 18 aggregated \$9,273,000,000, or about 5 per cent below the total of \$9,786,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The decline for New York City was \$450,000,000, or about 9.7 per cent.

As compared with the corresponding period of last year, total debits for the week under review show an increase of \$275,000,000, or about 3 per cent. Increases over last year's figures are reported for most of the leading centers, although New York City, Philadelphia, New Orleans, and Dallas report smaller figures. Los Angeles reports an increase over the corresponding 1922 total of 52 per cent, Seattle - an increase of 40.5 per cent, and Pittsburgh - an increase of about 29 per cent. For New York City the decrease as compared with last year's total was \$300,304,000, or 6.7 per cent.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 250 centers of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
