BANK DEBITS

Bank debits for the week ending September 19 totaled \$9,726,342,000, marking an increase of \$1,409,908,000, or 17 per cent, over the total of \$8,316,434,000 reported for the preceeding week. These larger figures reflect in part the normal mid-month increase in bank debits, also payment of the third installment of income and profits taxes due on September 15. The increase for New York City was \$882,113,000 or 24 per cent.

Of the other larger centers Baltimore reports an increase of 44 per cent, San Francisco - an increase of 41 per cent, Los Angeles - an increase of 23 per cent and Boston - an increase of 18 per cent.

As compared with the week ending September 20 of last year, total debits for the week under review show a decline of \$9,131,000, or of about 1 per cent. New York City reports a decrease of \$396,742,000, or 8 per cent. The principal increases over last year's figures are shown for Los Angeles, Detroit, Milwaukee, and Cleveland.

Debits to individual accounts are shown for banks in 249 centers of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
