BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts for the week ending October 31 aggregated \$9,346,000,000 or 1.4 per cent in excess of the total of \$9,220,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reports an increase of \$271,000,000, San Francisco and Cleveland increases of \$18,000,000 each, and Philadelphia an increase of \$16,000,000. The largest decreases for the week are reported by St. Louis, with \$34,000,000, Chicago and Detroit with \$29,000,000 each, and Boston with \$15,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding period in 1922, debits for the week under review show a decrease from \$10,054,000,000 to \$9,346,000,000 or of about 7 per cent. New York City reports a decrease of \$791,000,000 and Boston a decrease of \$26,000,000. Principal increases are shown as follows: Los Angeles - \$38,000,000, Chicago - \$25,000,000, Detroit - \$15,000,000 and Cleveland and San Francisco - \$14,000,000 each. Weekly debits to individual accounts reported by New York City banks since midsummer of the present year have been invariably smaller than in 1922. Outside of New York City bank debits for each week of the present year, have been larger than those of last year.

Debits to individual accounts are reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in 250 centers of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve districts.
