BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending June 18, aggregated \$10,811,000,000 or 15.5 per cent above the total of \$9,358,000,000 reported for the preceding week. This large increase is due in part to the series of credit operations in connection with the June 15 installment of income tax payments, and in part also to the usual heavy mid-month payments. New York City reports an increase of \$934,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$101,000,000 and Philadelphia - an increase of \$94,000,000.

As compared with the corresponding week in 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$471,000,000 or 4.6 per cent. An increase of \$636,000,000 is reported for New York City. Philadelphia reports a decrease of \$32,000,000, Kansas City - a decrease of \$15,000,000, and Boston - a decrease of \$14,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were about \$10,216,000,000 as compared with \$8,802,347,000 for the preceding week and \$9,713,217,000 for the week ending June 20, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 253 centers, of which 245 are included in the summary by Federal Reserve districts.
