BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ending August 13, aggregated \$9,392,000,000 or 7.3 per cent below the total of \$10,135,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reports a decrease of \$473,000,000, Boston - a decrease of \$55,000,000, Chicago - a decrease of \$38,000,000 and Philadelphia - a decrease of \$30,000,000. Small increases are shown for a few of the important centers.

As compared with the week ending August 15, 1923, debits for the week under review show an increase of \$2,016,000,000 or 27.3 per cent. Most of the larger centers report increases over last year's figures. New York City shows an increase of \$1,659,000,000, Boston - an increase of \$80,000,000, Chicago - an increase of \$74,000,000, and Philadelphia - an increase of \$34,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, were \$8,880,440,000 as compared with \$9,577,181,000 for the preceding week and \$6,892,047,000 for the week ending August 15, 1923.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 255 centers, of which 243 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
