BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 16, aggregated \$12,150,000,000 or 39.9 per cent above the total of \$8,685,000,000 reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days. Larger debits than a week ago were reported by all the more important centers. New York City reported an increase of \$1,952,000,000, while other large increases were as follows: Chicago \$197,000,000, San Francisco \$122,000,000, Boston \$112,000,000, Los Angeles \$107,000,000, Philadelphia \$81,000,000 and Cleveland \$70,000,000.

As compared with the week ending September 17, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,814,000,000 or 17.6 per cent. The principal increases reported were New York City - \$1,178,000,000, Chicago - \$58,000,000, San Francisco - \$34,000,000 and Los Angeles - \$35,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to about \$11,430,000,000, as compared with \$8,123,973,000 for the preceding week and \$9,696,279,000 for the week ending September 17, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 256 centers, of which 254 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
