BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending November 11, aggregated \$12,557,000,000 or 2.3 per cent above the total of \$12,277,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$1,020,000,000 and Buffalo an increase of \$17,000,000, while relatively large reductions were reported as follows: Chicago \$259,000,000, San Francisco \$64,000,000, St. Louis \$38,000,000, Los Angeles \$33,000,000, New Orleans \$27,000,000 and Minneapolis \$26,000,000.

As compared with the week ending November 12, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,402,000,000 or 12.6 per cent. The principal increases are as follows: New York City \$1,225,000,000, Boston \$62,000,000, Detroit \$44,000,000, Pittsburgh \$43,000,000, Philadelphia \$34,000,000 and Buffalo \$24,000,000. Decreases of \$57,000,000, \$29,000,000 and \$24,000,000 were reported by Chicago, Minneapolis and Duluth, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to about \$11,879,000,000, as compared with \$11,548,316,000 for the preceding week and \$10,509,206,000 for the week ending November 12, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 254 centers, of which 253 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
