BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending December 16, aggregated \$13,827,000,000 or 11.8 per cent above the total of \$12,355,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$680,000,000, Chicago \$162,000,000, Philadelphia - \$141,000,000, San Francisco - \$111,000,000, Boston \$51,000,000, Detroit - \$39,000,000 and Cleveland \$31,000,000.

As compared with the week ending December 17, 1924, debits for the week under review are larger by \$1,414,000,000 or 11.4 per cent. Substantial increases were reported by most of the more important centers, the principal increases being as follows: New York City \$721,000,000, Philadelphia \$122,000,000, San Francisco \$105,000,000, Chicago \$80,000,000, and Boston and Detroit \$35,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$13,032,716,000, as compared with \$11,598,544,000 for the preceding week and \$11,678,816,000 for the week ending December 17, 1924.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 256 centers, of which 254 are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
