BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending February 24, aggregated \$10,150,000,000, or 11.9 per cent below the total of \$11,517,000,000, reported for the preceding week. The week included but five business days as February 22, Washington's birthday, was observed as a holiday throughout the country. New York City reported a reduction of \$703,000,000, while other large reductions were as follows: Chicago \$96,000,000, Philadelphia \$52,000,000, Boston \$36,000,000, St. Louis \$32,000,000, Los Angeles \$28,000,000, San Francisco \$27,000,000, Cincinnati \$24,000,000 and Cleveland \$23,000,000.

As compared with the week ending February 25, 1925, which also included but five business days, debits for the week under review are larger by \$206,000,000 or 2.1 per cent. Increases were reported by most of the more important centers, the largest increases being as follows: Chicago \$57,000,000, Pittsburgh \$34,000,000 and Detroit \$33,000,000. A reduction of \$121,000,000 was reported by banks in New York City.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$9,548,396,000 as compared with \$10,810,227,000 for the preceding week and \$9,389,090,000 for the week ending February 25, 1925.

Debits to individual accounts were reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in 258 centers, all of which are included in the summary by Federal reserve districts.
