BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board for banks in leading cities for the week ending April 28, aggregated \$12,462,000,000 or 2. per cent below the total of \$12,697,000,000 reported for the preceding week. New York City reported an increase of \$318,000,000, which was more than offset by decreases in other cities, the principal reductions being as follows: Chicago \$63,000,000, Detroit \$54,000,000, Boston \$50,000,000, Philadelphia \$35,000,000, St. Louis \$24,000,000, and Los Angeles \$19,000,000.

As compared with the week ending April 29, 1925, debits for the week under review are larger by \$2,039,000,000 or 20 per cent. New York City reported an increase of \$1,598,000,000, while other large increases are as follows: Chicago \$75,000,000, Boston \$69,000,000, San Francisco \$29,000,000, Cleveland \$23,000,000, Philadelphia \$22,000,000, and Detroit \$19,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January, 1919, amounted to \$11,797,393,000, as compared with \$11,956,900,000 for the preceding week and \$9,809,164,000 for the week ending April 29, 1925.
