BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending June 23, aggregated \$12,270,000,000 or 2.7 per cent below the total of \$12,615,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,226,000,000 or 11.1 per cent above those for the week ending June 24, 1925, New York City reporting an increase of \$876,000,000, while other large increases are as follows: Chicago \$83,000,000, St. Louis \$33,000,000, Detroit \$24,000,000, Los Angeles \$21,000,000, and Cleveland and San Francisco \$18,000,000 each. Reductions of \$52,000,000 and \$17,000,000 were reported by Philadelphia and Boston, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919, amounted to about \$11,569,000,000, as compared with \$11,886,507,000 for the preceding week and \$10,411,767,000 for the week ending June 24, 1925.
