BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 22, aggregated \$12,691,366,000 or 4.2 per cent above the total of \$12,175,539,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$997,640,000 or 8.5 per cent above those for the week ending September 23, 1925. New York City reports an increase of \$579,000,000, as compared with last year; Chicago \$69,000,000, Philadelphia \$48,000,000, Boston \$42,000,000, and Cleveland and Los Angeles \$22,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,944,330,000 as compared with \$11,430,197,000 for the preceding week and \$10,998,478,000 for the week ending September 23, 1925.
