BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 17, aggregated \$12,512,000.00, or 3.2 per cent above the total of \$12,126,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The current week included but five business days at most of the reporting centers.

Total debits for the week under review are \$1,640,000,000 or 11.6 per cent below those for the week ending November 12, 1925, which included six business days. New York City reported a reduction of \$1,004,000,000, Chicago \$144,000,000, Philadelphia \$53,000,000, Pittsburgh \$38,000,000, San Francisco \$33,000,000, Los Angeles \$27,000,000, Baltimore \$24,000,000, New Orleans \$23,000,000, and Minneapolis \$22,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,726,212,000 as compared with \$11,338,616,000 for the preceding week and \$13,313,251,000 for the week ending November 18, 1925.
