BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 8, 1926, aggregated \$12,270,000,000 or 7.1 per cent above the total of \$11,460,720,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$106,792,000 or .9 per cent below those for the week ending December 9, 1925. New York City reported a decline of \$213,000,000, Minneapolis \$23,000,000, Pittsburgh \$21,000,000 and Detroit and St. Louis \$14,000,000 each. The largest increases were \$106,000,000 for Chicago, \$23,000,000 for Philadelphia and \$19,000,000 for Los Angeles.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,491,949,000 as compared with \$10,758,166,000 for the preceding week and \$11,617,997,000 for the week ending December 9, 1925.
