BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending January 26, 1927, aggregated \$12,400,000,000 or 8.6 per cent below the total of \$13,563,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$7,000,000 above those for the week ending January 27, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$68,000,000, Boston \$32,000,000 and Los Angeles \$27,000,000, while Chicago reported a reduction of \$113,000,000, Pittsburgh \$29,000,000, Detroit \$21,000,000 and Philadelphia \$19,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,679,396,000 as compared with \$12,752,573,000 for the preceding week and \$11,692,851,000 for the week ending January 27, 1926.
