## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 16, 1927, aggregated \$12,555,000,000 or 1 per cent above the total of \$12,497,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$1,127,000,000 or 9.8 per cent above those for the week ending February 17, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$971,000,000, Boston \$50,000,000, San Francisco \$45,000,000, Los Angeles \$30,000,000, Philadelphia \$25,000,000 and Cleveland \$23,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,952,275,000, as compared with \$11,791,562,000 for the preceding week and \$10,815,504,000 for the week ending February 17, 1926.
