BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending April 27, 1927, aggregated \$13,497,000,000 or 8.1 per cent above the total of \$12,487,000,000 reported for the preceding week.

Total debits for the week under review are \$1,020,000,000⁰⁰⁰ or 8.2 per cent above those for the week ending April 28, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$532,000,000, San Francisco \$91,000,000, Chicago \$51,000,000, Philadelphia \$41,000,000, Boston \$34,000,000, Los Angeles \$24,000,000, and Cincinnati and Pittsburgh \$23,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$12,773,224,000, as compared with \$11,717,882,000 for the preceding week and \$11,802,847,000 for the week ending April 28, 1926.
