BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending September 14, 1927, aggregated \$13,921,554,000 or 21.1 per cent above the total of \$11,499,033,000 reported for the preceding week, which had but five business days.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,748,374,000 or 14.4 per cent above those for the week ending September 15, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$1,394,000,000, Chicago \$119,000,000, Boston \$99,000,000, San Francisco \$45,000,000 and New Orleans and Minneapolis \$20,000,000 each.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$13,175,106,000 as compared with \$10,846,067,000 for the preceding week and \$11,436,583,000 for the week ending September 15, 1926.
