BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 30, 1927 aggregated \$12,484,000,000 or 15.1 per cent below the total of \$14,696,000,000 reported for the preceding week. The current week included but five business days, November 24, Thanksgiving Day, being observed as a holiday throughout the country.

Debits for the week under review are \$1,025,000,000 or 8.9 per cent above those for the week ending December 1, 1926, which also contained but five business days. New York City reported an increase of \$885,000,000, San Francisco \$75,000,000, Boston \$56,000,000 and Detroit \$23,000,000, while Chicago and Philadelphia reported reductions of \$47,000,000 and \$25,000,000, respectively.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$11,800,784,000 as compared with \$13,903,699,000 for the preceding week and \$10,764,320,000 for the week ending December 1, 1926.
