BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending December 7, 1927, aggregated \$15,627,000,000 or 25.2 per cent above the total of \$12,479,000,000 reported for the preceding week, which included but five business days.

Debits for the week under review are \$3,365,000,000 or 27.4 per cent above those for the week ending December 8, 1926. New York City reported an increase of \$2,387,000,000, Boston \$196,000,000, San Francisco \$137,000,000, Chicago \$130,000,000, Philadelphia \$73,000,000, Detroit \$28,000,000, Cleveland \$26,000,000, St. Louis \$25,000,000, Los Angeles \$23,000,000, Newark \$21,000,000 and Minneapolis \$20,000,000.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$14,800,117,000 as compared with \$11,800,784,000 for the preceding week and \$11,498,728,000 for the week ending December 8, 1926.
