BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending July 10, which included but five business days, aggregated \$15,513,000,000 or 31 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and approximately the same as reported for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to approximately \$14,704,000,000, as compared with \$21,495,000,000 for the preceding week and \$14,554,000,000 for the week ending July 11, of last year.
