BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 12, which included but five business days for many of the reporting centers, aggregated \$11,677,000,000 or 26 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and 31 per cent below the total reported for the corresponding week of last year which also included but five business days in many of the reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$10,995,000,000, as compared with \$14,917,000,000 for the preceding week and \$16,076,000,000 for the week ending February 13 of last year.
