## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 26, which included but five business days, aggregated \$12,748,000,000 or 17 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week, and 21 per cent below the total reported for the corresponding week of last year, which also included but five business days.

Aggregate debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$12,047,000,000, as compared with \$14,507,000,000 for the preceding week and \$15,442,000,000 for the week ending February 27 of last year.
