BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 25, aggregated \$8,892,000,000, or 13 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 30 per cent below the total reported for the corresponding week of last year. The current week and the corresponding week a year ago included but five business days in all reporting centers. The week ending February 18, 1931 included five business days in most reporting centers.

Aggregated debits for 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to about \$8,338,000,000, as compared with \$9,558,000,000 for the preceding week and \$12,040,000,000 for the week ending February 26 of last year.
