BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending November 11, aggregated \$7,192,000,000, or 10 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 37 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year. The week ending November 11 of this year and the corresponding week of last year both included but five business days in nearly all of the reporting centers, and the week ending November 4 of the present year included only five business days in a number of the larger reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$6,675,000,000, as compared with \$7,360,000,000 the preceding week and \$10,702,000,000 the week ending November 12 of last year.
