BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending February 24, aggregated \$5,862,000,000, or 28 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 34 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year. All three weeks included but five business days in all or many of the reporting centers.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amounted to \$5,413,000,000, as compared with \$6,630,000,000 the preceding week and \$8,338,000,000 the week ending February 25 of last year.
