BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending October 12, which included but five business days in many of the reporting cities, aggregated \$5,274,000,000, or 28 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 36 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debitw for the 141 centers for which figures have been published weekly since January 1919 amount to about \$4,876,000,000, as compared with \$6,761,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,720,000,000 the week ending October 14 of last year.
