## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending May 24, aggregated \$5,703,000,000, or 10 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 2 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 centers for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,328,000,000, as compared with \$5,910,000,000 for the preceding week and \$5,154,000,000 for the week ending May 25 of last year.
