## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ending August 2, aggregated \$7,099,000,000, or 12 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 5 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,665,000,000, compared with \$7,651,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,997,000,000 the week ending August 3 of last year.
