BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 6, which included only five business days, aggregated \$5,318,000,000, or 7 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 3 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$4,962,000,000, compared with \$5,391,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,070,000,000, the week ended September 7 of last year.
