BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended December 27, which included but five business days, aggregated \$5,299,000,000, or 23 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 7 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included but five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$4,905,000,000, compared with \$6,333,000,000 the preceding week and \$4,584,000,000 the week ended December 23 of last year.
