BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended April 18, aggregated \$8,457,000,000, or 8 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 65 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year, which included five business days in some of the reporting cities.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,977,000,000, compared with \$7,383,000,000 the preceding week and \$4,756,000,000 the week ended April 19 of last year.
