BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended May 30, which included five business days in most of the reporting cities, aggregated \$5,334,000,000, or 17 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 6 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year, which also included five business days in most of the reporting cities.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$4,966,000,000, compared with \$6,008,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,322,000,000 the week ended May 31 of last year.
