BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 6, aggregated \$7,615,000,000, or 43 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included five business days in most of the reporting cities, and 6 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$7,073,000,000, compared with \$4,966,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,730,000,000 the week ended June 7 of last year.
