## BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended June 27, aggregated \$6,621,000,000, or 20 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 3 percent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,168,000,000, compared with \$7,723,000,000, the preceding week and \$6,409,000,000 the week ended June 28 of last year.
