BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended August 1, aggregated \$7,015,000,000, or 11 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 1 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,548,000,000, compared with \$5,872,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,665,000,000 the week ended August 2 of last year.
