BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 12, aggregated \$6,042,000,000, or 8 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week which included only five business days, and 8 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,579,000,000, compared with \$5,192,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,214,000,000 the week ended September 13 of last year.
