BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended September 26, aggregated \$6,018,000,000, or 13 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 3 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$5,574,000,000, compared with \$6,425,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,764,000,000 the week ended September 27, of last year.
