**BANK DEBITS**

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 2, aggregated \$8,208,000,000, or 39 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 6 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year. Each of the three weeks included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,648,000,000, compared with \$5,473,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,228,000,000 the week ended January 3 of last year.
