BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 6, aggregated \$7,117,000,000, or 1 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 3 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,578,000,000, compared with \$6,638,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,831,000,000 the week ended February 7 of last year.
