BANK DEBITS

Federal Reserve Board
February 25, 1935.

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended February 20, aggregated \$7,611,000,000, or 26 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 3 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,077,000,000, compared with \$5,635,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,866,000,000 the week ended February 21 of last year.
