BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended March 20, aggregated \$8,183,000,000, or 13 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 9 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$7,630,000,000, compared with \$6,743,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,991,000,000 the week ended March 21 of last year.
