BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by business banks in leading cities for the week ended April 24, which included five days in some of the reporting cities, aggregated \$6,991,000,000, or 12 per cent below the total reported for the preceding week and 5 per cent below the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,504,000,000, compared with \$7,409,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,908,000,000 the week ended April 25 of last year.
