BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported to the Federal Reserve Board by banks in leading cities for the week ended July 24, aggregated \$7,469,000,000, or 12 percent below the total reported for the preceding week and 18 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$6,977,000,000, compared with \$7,968,000,000 the preceding week and \$5,872,000,000 the week ended July 25 of last year.
