BANK DEBITS

Board of Governors
of the Federal Reserve System
October 5, 1935

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended October 2, aggregated \$9,413,000,000, or 32 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week and 31 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to about \$8,792,000,000, compared with \$6,623,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,610,000,000 the week ended October 3 of last year.
