BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended November 20, aggregated \$8,754,000,000, or 21 per cent above the total reported for the preceding week, which included only five business days in most of the reporting cities, and 26 per cent above the total for the corresponding week of last year.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,083,000,000, compared with \$6,689,000,000 the preceding week and \$6,369,000,000 the week ended November 21 of last year.
