BANK DEBITS

Debits to individual accounts, as reported by banks in leading cities for the week ended January 1, aggregated \$9,071,000,000, or 22 percent above the total reported for the preceding week and 10 percent above the total for the corresponding week of last year. Each of the three weeks included only five business days.

Aggregate debits for the 141 cities for which a separate total has been maintained since January 1919 amounted to \$8,436,000,000, compared with \$6,881,000,000 the preceding week and \$7,656,000,000 the week ended January 2 of last year.
